

# **Graduation Requirements**

Here's are the classes/credits you need to graduate:

- 4 English credits (one per year)
- 4 Math credits (including 1 credit of Algebra II or its equivalent)
- 3 Social Studies credits (one per year)
- 3 Science credits (1 biological, 1 physical, and 1 advanced science)
- ½ Health credit
- ½ Physical Education credit (must take 2 PE classes or earn the PE waiver)
- 1 Fine Arts credit in 7th-12th (Art, Choir, or Band)
- ½ Financial Literacy credit
- 3.5-4.5 additional elective credits:
  - Elective classes can be Foreign Language, Business, Family & Consumer Science, Fine Art, Career Tech, or additional core classes beyond the minimum required.
- You must earn at least 20 credits to graduate.
- You must meet state testing requirements and earn TWO seals (see the next slide).

- 5. 2 units of a Foreign Language
- 6. 4 credits of Career-Technical Education Curriculum
- 7. Maintain a 3.5 GPA on 4.0 scale
- 8. ACT score of 27 / SAT score of 1210
- 9. Achieve proficiency benchmark on Competency Assessment
