- e. Authorize the Treasurer to borrow funds in anticipation of future tax receipts as permitted by Ohio Revised Code 133.301 at the best available rate for cash flow purposes.

- f. Authorize the Treasurer to pay professional meeting expenses for the Superintendent and Treasurer within the appropriation accounts.
- g. Authorize the Treasurer to continue the practice of allowing Board members to participate, at their own expense, in group health, dental and vision insurance plans provided to employees of the district as permitted by Ohio Revised Code 3313.202.
- h. Authorize the Treasurer or Superintendent to accept all donations to the school district on behalf of the Board of Education.
- i. Authorize the Treasurer or Superintendent to enter into and/or accept/participate in Federal, State or Local Grants or agreements and authorize the Treasurer to appropriate funds for the grants awarded.
- j. Authorize the Superintendent to purchase textbooks, school supplies, and equipment, and to authorize emergency repairs to buildings and equipment to be made against the appropriate accounts of the Board adopted Appropriation Measure.
- k. Authorize the Superintendent to send school employees to professional meetings within the amount of appropriation for calendar 2018.
- Authorize the Superintendent to approve all special trips on school buses, including educational field trips for band and athletic activities, based on guidelines as defined in Board policy.
- m. Authorize the Superintendent to approve the attendance and reimbursement of expenses made against the appropriate accounts of the Board adopted Appropriation Measure, incurred by certified and classified staff members at professional and/or in-service training meetings, based on guidelines as defined in Board Policy.
