JOB DESCRIPTION COVENTRY LOCAL SCHOOLS BEHAVIOR SPECIALIST

FUNCTION OF JOB

Under the general supervision of the superintendent, the direct supervision of the director of special services and the immediate supervision of the building principal, to provide behavioral management and academic instruction for identified students with disabilities. These services will be provided in accordance with the State of Ohio's <u>Rules for the Education of Handicapped Children</u> and the Ohio Model Policies and Procedures for Educating Children with Disabilities.

CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES

- 1. Will serve students who have been diagnosed, through a multi-factored assessment, as demonstrating a specific disability.
- 2. Provide direct academic instruction in accordance with the goals established on each student's Individualized Educational Program (I.E.P.).
- 3. Implement a behavior management program in accordance with the goals established on each student's I.E.P.
- 4. Develop and implement behavioral and instructional techniques and materials as needed to meet educational goals as stated in each student's I.E.P.
- 5. Monitor and support each student's progress in relation to the goals established in the I.E.P., by establishing and maintaining contact with the student's teachers, parents, counselor, and principal.
- 6. Maintain and provide data to evaluate each student's progress in relation to the goals established in the I.E.P.
- 7. Participate as a team member in all facets of the development and implementation of each student's I.E.P.
- 8. Attend meetings and in-service programs as directed by the building principal and special services director.
- 9. Effectively carry out other duties assigned by the building principal, special services director, or superintendent in keeping with the negotiated agreement.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Must hold a current and valid Ohio Special Education teacher's certificate to teach children with disabilities or
- 2. Must hold a current and valid Ohio Social Worker Certificate/License.
