



1. Login to Google Classroom using your @coventrycomets.org account.


2. Open the file through the classwork tab in your Google Classroom. Click on the assignment.



3. Click on the 3 dots in the top right-hand corner and select 'open in new window'.




4. Now you will see the extensions menu 'Open with'. Choose your extension and begin editing...




Editing with Adobe Acrobat

Adobe is the simplest of the PDF editing extensions. You can comment, highlight, and draw.




The file saves as you go and your teacher can see modifications immediately.




Editing with Kami


1. Select Annotate with Kami
